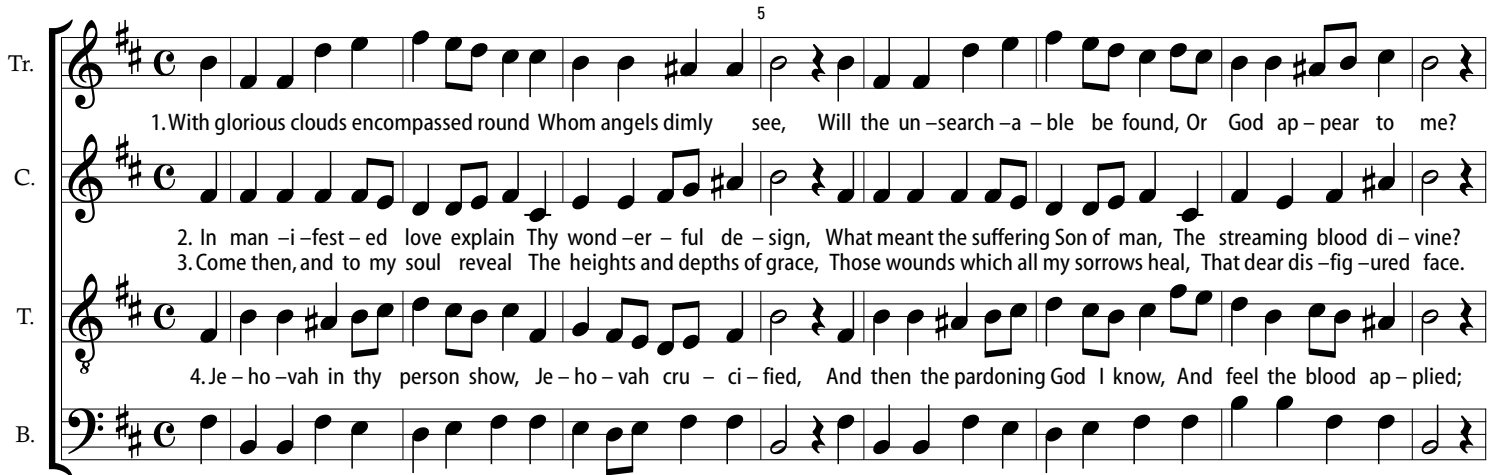

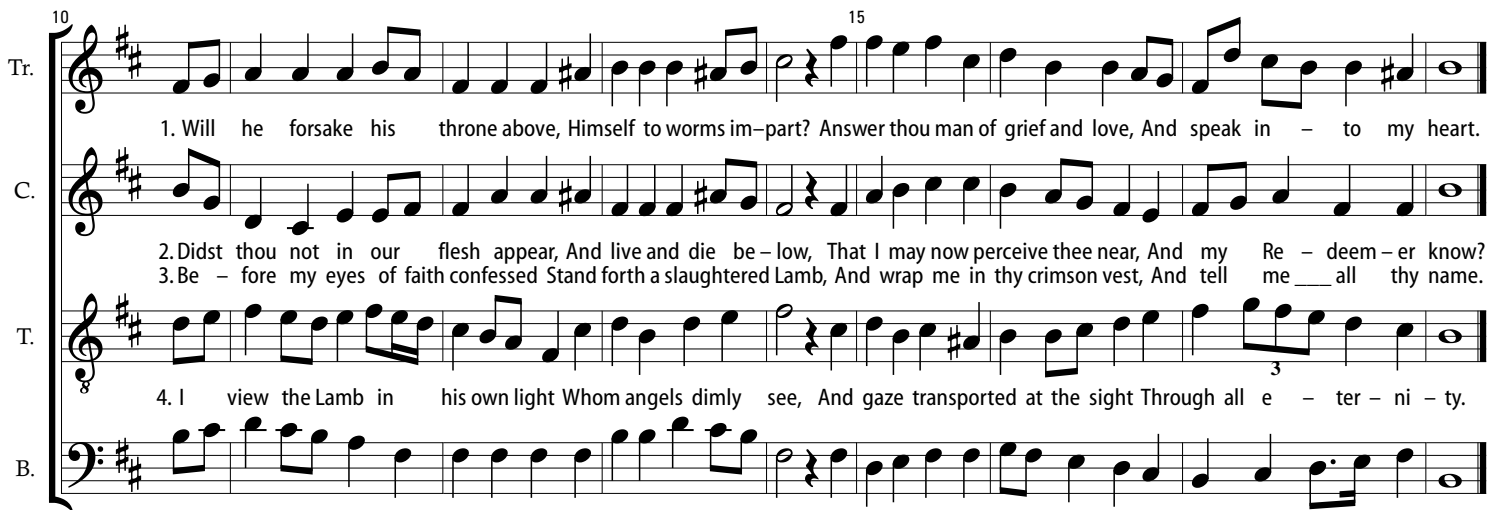
Tr. 1. With glorious clouds encompassed round Whom angels dimly see, Will the un-search-a-ble be found, Or God ap-pear to me?
