Thomas Knight (or Knyght) was Lay Vicar at Salisbury in the early 16th Century, becoming "Instructor of the Choristers" at some point between 1526 and 1529. He was in post until at least 1543, and possibly as late as 1550.



Tenuto markings are editorial, and should not be interpreted in the modern sense: they are used to indicate word stresses, particularly where they do not fall upon the strong beats of the bar. 3/2 bars may be felt interchangeably as 3 groups of 2, or 2 groups of 3, depending on the pattern of the words.
