BASS ONLY 1. He that dwelleth in the shelter of the ^{••} Most ' High,
and abideth in the ' shadow of ' the Al ' mighty,
He shall say to the Lord: "Thou art my protector ' and my ' refuge!
My God, in ' Whom I ' put my ' trust."

SA 6. He hath given His angels charge ' ov-er ' thee,
to ' keep thee in ' all thy ' ways;

lest thou dash thy ' foot a ' gainst a ' stone.

TB 2. For He will rescue thee from the ' snare of the ' fowler,

TB 3. Like a shield His ' truth shall ' guard thee;

Nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the plague that ' prowls in the ' dark,
nor the ' noonday at ' tack of the ' demon.

BASS ONLY 8. He will call upon Me and ' I will ' hear him;
I will be with him in need, I will rescue ' him and ' bring him ' honour.
With length of days I will ' satis-fy ' him,
and ' show him ' My sal ' vation".

BASS ONLY 4. A thousand shall fall at thy side and ten thousand at ' thy right ' hand,
yet no ' evil shall ' come to ' thee.
But with thine eyes ' thou shalt ' see
and behold the ' punish-ment ' of the ' wicked.
