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3. But let the iuft : be glad in thys : and ioy in God hys fight :  
For Gods great power : & ftable truth : in myrth let them delite.
4. O fmg to God : found out hys name : fce hym ye magnify :  
He rydeth on heauens : hys name is God : from face of earth to fce.
5. He father is : to fatherles : of widowes iudge he is :  
Euen God hymfelfe : which euer dwelth : in holy place of hys.
6. Thys God he makth the defolate : in houfholdes great to grow :  
He lofeth the thrall : quyte out of bandes : and bringth the wycked low.
7. O God when thou : wentft forth as guide : before the people out  
When thou dydft walke in wyldernes : which thyng thou dydft no doubt.

22. God fayd I will : reftore as once : from Baſan myne I dyd :  
I will returne : all myne as once : from feas moft depe I ryd.
23. That dipt thy fceete : in all their bloud : may reade appeare all eye :  
That dogs myght licke : their ennies bloud : fo read to be therby
24. Who lyft did fce : O puiffaunt God : thy great procedings hie :  
The goings iuft : of thee my God : my king in fanctuary.
25. Whẽ thanks were ſong : firft fingers went : the minftrels moued theyr fceete :  
In myds were fet : the damfel maides : who playd with timbrels fwẽete.
26. When they in one : were ioyntly met : thus god they prayfed wel :  
From hart the ground : they bleft the Lord : who fprang of Ifrael
27. Small Beniamin : there ruler went : fo Iudas tribe theyr ftone :  
So went the Pieres : of Zebulon : and Neptaly came on.
28. Thus god hath bid all frẽgth & power : for thee ful nye to be :  
With ftrength O God : cõfirme this worke : that y haft wrought to frẽe.
