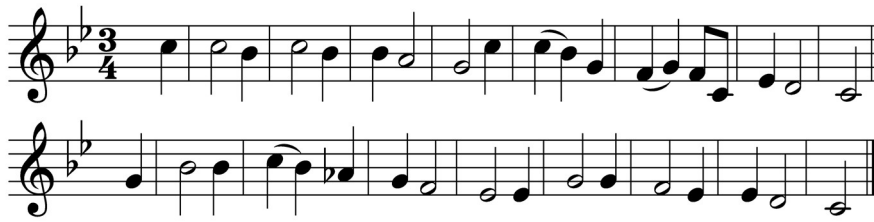


A hymn of glory let us sing Hymnal 1982 no. 218 Melody: Deo gracias (as at hymn 449) L.M.
