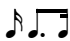

Although the sources for this anthem are written in 10 parts, with intricate alternations and doublings between Decani and Cantoris, there are never more than 8 real parts sounding at any given time. This edition distributes the parts over 8 staves to fit the layout and range of a modern SSAATTBB choir.
